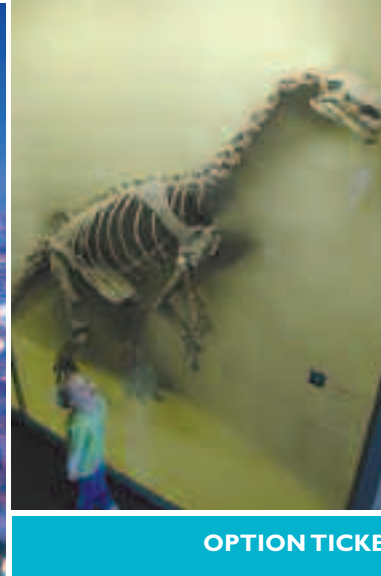

## Harvard Museum of Natural History OR John F. Kennedy Presidential Library and Museum

Explore 12,000 specimens from around the globe, including dinosaurs, meteorites, gemstones and hundreds of animals – all at the University's most visited museum. Get close to the world's only mounted *Kronosaurus*, a 42-foot long marine reptile. See the 1,642-lb amethyst geode and three whale skeletons. 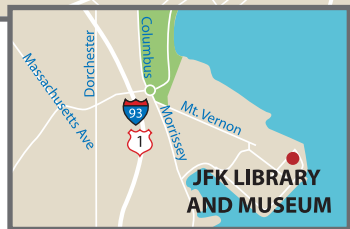
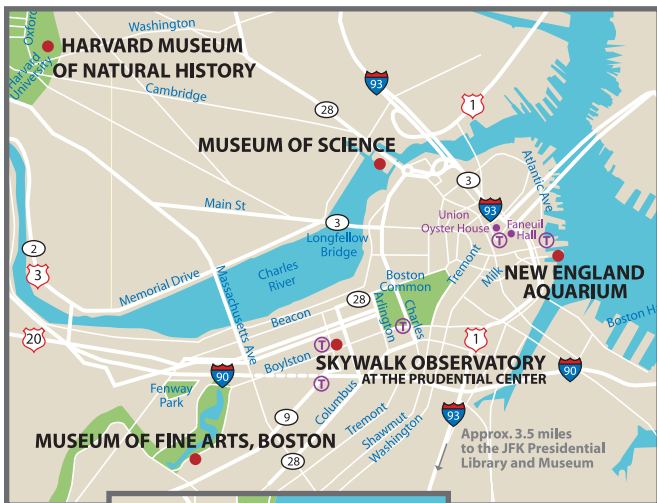

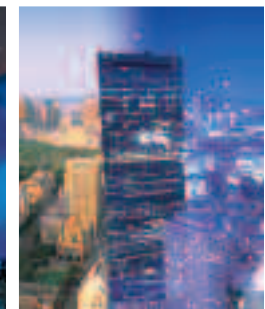
