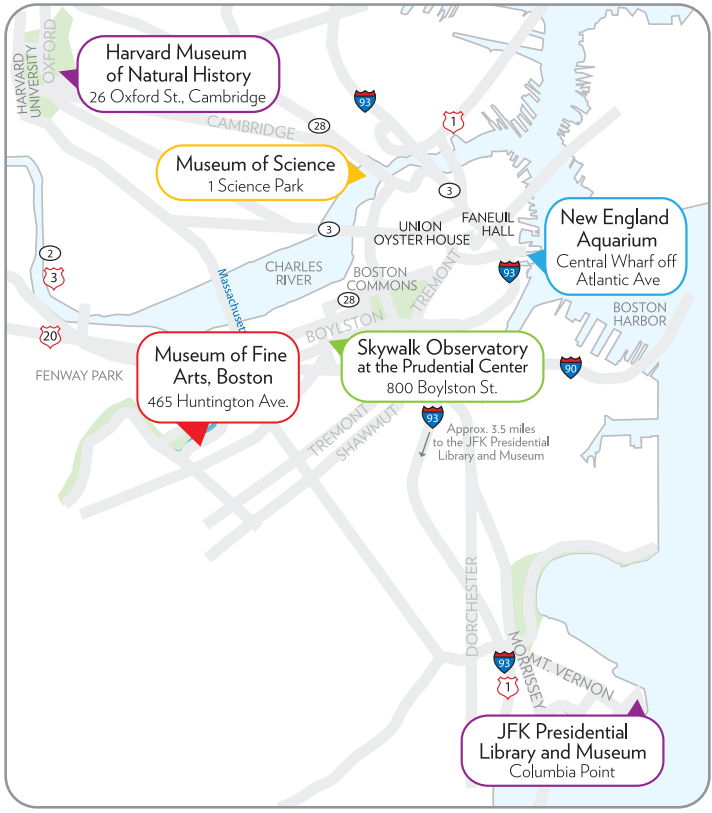

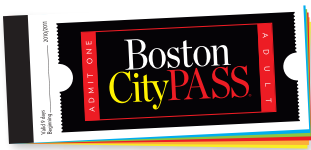

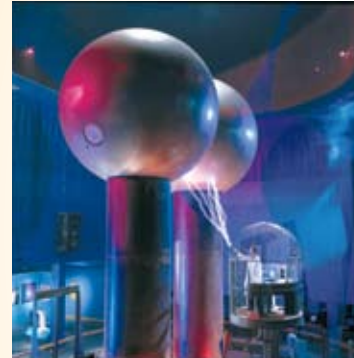

John F. Kennedy Presidential Library and Museum

Step back into the re-created world of the early 1960s and experience first-hand the life and legacy of John and Jacqueline Kennedy through 25 exhibits, three theaters and 20 video presentations. Designed by I.M. Pei, the national memorial offers panoramic views of Boston's skyline and Harbor islands. 2010 and 2011 mark the 50th Anniversary of the Kennedy Presidency, the 1960 election victory and the thousand days of promise and new beginnings that followed.
