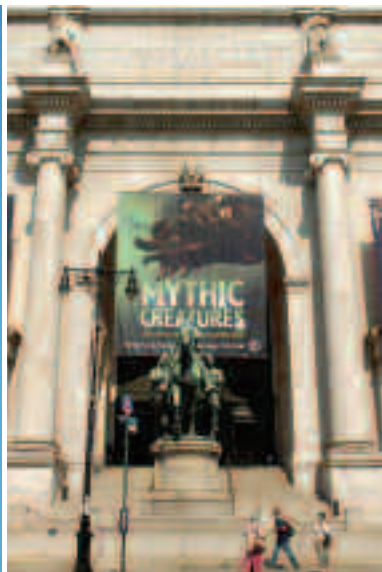


Empire State Building Observatory
