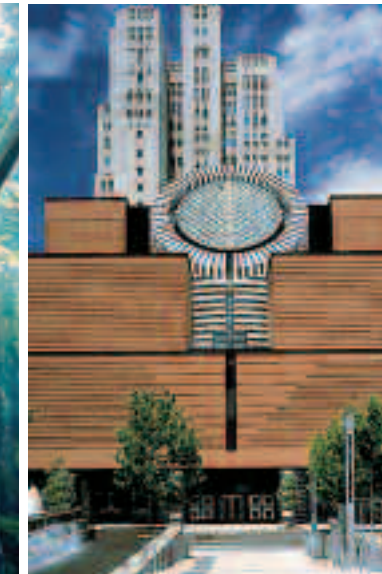


Aquarium of the Bay
